Considerations


- School puts in place initiatives, processes and ensures diligence for traffic/vehicle safety during school drop-offs and dismissals.

- It is an on-going and continual effort between stakeholders.






School Safety Guide – Parents' Handbook

queue up from Lamppost 40A








Road Safety near the School

 Arrival and Dismissal by foot, bus or private vehicles:

Potential safety concerns:

- Concentration of vehicles and students;
- Blind-spots (parked/illegally parked vehicles, around bends);
- Vehicles in-a-rush (late or impatient).



3 gates for Arrivals and






School's Actions & Initiatives

- During the beginning-of-year and mid-year Parents-Teachers
 Meetings, the school briefs and reminds parents on the safety rules and considerations when dropping-off and picking-up the students.
- Remind parents via School Parents Gateway (PG)/Principal's Letter.
- Briefing the students during school assemblies.
- **Stagger dismissals** of students in 3 groups (Grp 1: school bus; Grp 2: public transport/walk; Grp 3: private transport pickup).
- **Directing & managing the traffic situation** by school security officers and staff.
- Report illegal parking via LTA-online by school staff.
- Work with LTA to deploy Parking Wardens at strategic timings.






Traffic & Road Safety - Gate 1 (Martia Road)



Arrival Procedures

- School buses usually arrive either before and/or around 7am.
- Please **join the queue** to drop your daughter off.
- There are multiple drop-off points to ease congestion.
- Please move to the furthest available drop-off point or as directed by school staff.
- Do not alight from your car to escort your daughter out or help her put on her bag (She should already have her bag on her and ready to exit the car).
- **School staff will help** her if she needs help.





Dismissal Procedures

- Parents/Drivers should arrive AT or AFTER 1.40pm (there is less traffic, and you will be able to pick your daughter easily).
- Please do NOT park along the private houses or OPPOSITE
 SIDE as it will block the buses and cars in the private houses.
- Instead, please queue and pick your girls at the waiting area.



Traffic & Road Safety - Gate 2 & 3 (Marine Parade Road)



- Please **join the queue** to drop your daughter off.
- Do not cut in from the middle lane to prevent collision with the cars or school buses already in the queue.
- Do not stop your car, alight and walk your daughter to the gate.
- Do not stop your car at the bus bay, alight and walk your daughter to the gate.



Dismissal Procedures

- Please **do NOT park and wait in the middle lane** of Marine Parade Road.
- Please do NOT wait in the middle lane and ask your daughter to cross the first lane to get to the middle lane.
- Please do not park at the bus bay and alight.
- Instead, please queue and pick your girls at the waiting areas.

Advisory/Instruction from LTA for Marine Parade Road:

- Queuing of vehicles between lamp post 40A to 46A on only one lane
- However, there should be strictly no waiting/parking along the bus bay and at the junction between Marine Parade Road and Still Road
- This includes parking abreast of another queuing vehicle.

Road Safety near the School

Tips and Suggestions to ensure traffic safety and to ease congestion:

- Bags and lunch bags should be packed and ready the night before.
- Kisses and hugs should be given at home.
- Your daughter should be ready to exit the car bag ready, masks on (if needed), allowance given.
- Seat her to the left
- There is no need: (1) to sit at the back with her or (2) exit the car with her, hug her, then get back into the front seat.

Remember:

- We need to work as partners for the safety of our girls Be On-time, Be
 Patient, Be Considerate.
- Watch out for dangerous mindsets— "It is okay, just this once", "There are no cars behind me"....




Road Safety: Cycling/Scootering to School

- Observe road safety when cycling / skate biking along the road or pavement.
- Remember to use the helmet.

When arriving at school:

- Dismount from the bicycle / skate bike.
- Push bicycle / skate bike in the school compound and look out for other students around.
- Park at designated area.









Safety - Taking the School Bus



- Please remind your daughters that they need to be belted up on the bus.
- They should not be playing or running on the bus.
- It is challenging for the bus driver to remind the girls to be seated as he focused on the road.



School Safety & Security

- Parents/Guardians are not allowed on the school premises - this is to ensure the safety of the girls.
- Our aim is to **prevent any intruder** from entering the school premises.
- All visitors need to be registered at the security officer's counter.
- Parents who are picking up their daughters during curriculum time should register with the security officer.
- At arrival and dismissal, parents are only allowed to wait at Gate 1 (Martia Road). They are not allowed to enter the school by any other gate.
 - Turnstiles are installed to ensure the safety of the girls and to prevent intruders.

Response Measures to Communicable Diseases in Schools

- Conduct visual screening of students.
- Unwell students will be advised to stay away from school and to seek medical attention if necessary.
- Students who are recovering from respiratory-related illnesses will be advised to exercise social responsibility by wearing a mask and minimising social interactions with big groups.
- Students will be advised to **maintain good personal hygiene** and improve hand hygiene by making hand sanitizers and soap available in the appropriate areas throughout the school.
- School will ensure the **cleaning and disinfection** of frequently touched surfaces, including door handles, staircase railings, water coolers etc.
- School will also ensure that classrooms are well and naturally ventilated
