Sea slugs are small, slow-moving ocean creatures known for their bright colours and intricate patterns. They can measure an eight of an inch long to 12 inches.

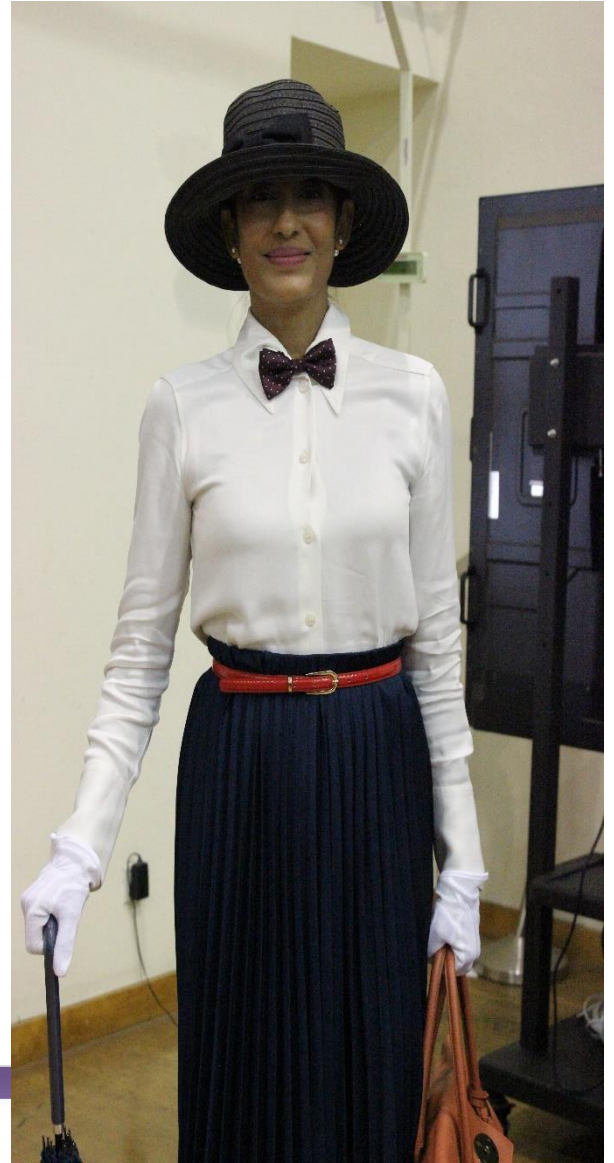

Parents' Support

- **Home support** – to help children learn English by providing English language reading materials at home.
- **Activate child's interest** – show your child that you believe learning English is both enjoyable and useful in your daily life.



STELLAR needs Parents' Support

- **Role models** – read and write notes and messages in front of your child.
- **Understanding** – English language learning requires frequent exposure to listening, speaking, reading and writing opportunities and activities rather than use of worksheets alone.



How you can help your child

- **Allow your child to choose books to read and reread**
- **Read to and with your child (or, have your child read to you)**
 - Remember that reading in a mother tongue language also fosters a love for books and knowledge
- **Talk about the books and characters read**
