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Please note:

1. The duration of each written examination is the actual testing time. This does not include the distribution and collection of examination papers.
2. Students will attend school at normal school hours on examination days.
3. There will be **NO** make-up for the Mid Year Examination (MYE) except for our Oral Examination.
4. Students who are absent for an examination would need to furnish the school with a **Medical Certificate** for the pro-ration of their marks.
5. Students who are assessed by a doctor to be low-risk and with mild symptoms, and tested positive with a healthcare-administered ART or students who are well and self-tested positive (i.e. did not see a doctor), a photograph of the self-administered positive ART result would need to be sent to the Form Teacher for the pro-ration of their marks.
6. If students are unwell, they are not to come to school and to see a doctor immediately.
7. The Oral and Written Examinations will be conducted in compliance with the prevailing Safe Measurement Measures (SMM).
